**Payment Terms:**

These are Annual School Fees and Student Levy for the 2021 school year. Families have the options to pay the **total school fee account in full** at commencement of the school year or in **3 instalments** at the commencement of Terms 1, 2 & 3, or **Direct Debit, Credit Card, Electronic Funds Transfer** (Bank Transfer) or **Cash**.

Payments can be made by Bank Transfer (as below), Direct Debit (please fill the direct debit form attached) or in person through other facilities such as EFTPOS or Cash

- The Direct Debit facility is a proven success to spread the annual payment throughout the school year. **The Weekly Payment for a one child family (fee + levy) using Direct Debit is \$70** (Excluding Swimming, Camp & Sacramental Levy).

Other arrangements might be available for family experiencing financial difficulties impacting ability to pay school fees. Please do not hesitate to discuss this with Geraldine or Claire on 8432 4500.

Families who have a valid Health Care Card might be eligible for a **\$125** per child from the Victorian Government. This payment are made directly to the school and when received, will be applied against your school fees for the students' sports, excursion, and camp expenses. To claim the payment for 2021, please complete a CSEF form and submit to our office no later than the first week of term 2 (**14 April 2021**).
